Dear Yr 4 Parent/Carer (Current Yr 3)

Re: **Swimming Programme**

It is the PE National Curriculum requirement that children should be offered the opportunity to learn to swim 25 metres by the end of Key Stage 2 and I am, therefore, very pleased to advise that we have arranged lessons for your child. We realise that many children can already swim but as it is part of the National Curriculum we have to work within the guidelines set down by the Government. Each class has a 1/2 hour (30 minute) lesson every Wednesday afternoon for 5 weeks. There is no cost to parents for these lessons as the school pays for this as part of the curriculum although parents are asked to pay the travel costs on the coach amounting £16.75 per child.

Payment can be made in 3 ways:

- On line payments using your personal login details, scroll down to Yr 4 Swimming 2017/18 - you can pay this in staged payments as well.
- Staged payments by cash or cheque and a payment card will be issued to you. Cheques should be made payable to Liphook Junior School.
- Payment in full.

Please note that by paying on line we accept this as permission from you that your child is allowed to take part in this trip. We still need you to return the reply slip if you wish to help and also return the form confirming your child's swimming ability.

By offering you the different options for paying for the coach this will allow you plenty of time to spread the cost over the weeks if you wish. The swimming programme will be held at the Mill Chase Leisure Centre, Bordon, and qualified swimming instructors have been arranged. All children will be assessed as part of their first lesson as to their swimming capability and class teacher and additional helpers will be accompanying the children every week. On the reverse of this letter are full details of dates, times, equipment needed and I would kindly ask that you please keep this information in a safe place to remind you.

Several parent helpers are required to help supervise the children in the changing rooms. Please indicate on the slip below if you are able to help. However, all parents accompanying children must be DBS cleared. This is a simple process; simply let us have your full name together with your email address and a link will be sent to you. Attached to this letter is a form that needs to be completed and returned asap about your child's capability/confidence in the water.

If your child uses an EpiPen or Asthma Inhaler

EpiPen and Asthma inhaler users will take with them on their swimming lessons the ones that are held in the classroom
