Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our Rivers topic in the first half of the Autumn term, your children will be visiting Fishbourne Pond, the River Lavant and Dell Quay in Chichester Harbour. This fabulous trip will provide the children with first-hand experience of a river's progress to the sea. Chichester Harbour Education Service Officers will be leading the walk from Fishbourne to Dell Quay and supervising the investigations the children will undertake. Two class teachers will lead each visit. We are sure you will agree this trip will provide fantastic hands-on learning!

The details of the visit are as follows:

Venue	:	Dell Quay, Chichester Harbour
Dates	:	Monday 25th September - Mrs Kadri's class + half of Ms O'Shea's class Tuesday 26th September - Mrs Noble + half of Ms O'Shea's class
Depart school	:	9:10 am
Return to school	:	3:00pm
Clothing	:	Waterproof coat (and waterproof trousers if you have them) Track suit bottoms, or loose trousers suitable for rough terrain (not shorts), school sweatshirt and school polo shirt, sun hat and sun cream (applied at home if appropriate)
Cost per child	:	£11.00

Please provide your child with a packed lunch including a water bottle. Children who are entitled to free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch by the school but this will not include a drink. On the day of the visit, please ensure your child is wearing sensible outdoor shoes which are suitable for distance walking.

The children should also bring named wellies in a named plastic carrier bag so they can take part in the river activities (where they actually get in the water). Please note: children will not be allowed in the water unless they have wellies.

***If your child uses an Epipen or an Asthma inhaler they will take the ones that are held in the classroom.***

To allow the trip to go ahead, we need additional help and we'd love to hear from any parents or friends who are interested in accompanying us. As with all our activities, all helpers must hold a DBS certificate; if you do not have one, please call into the school office and they will send you a link via e-mail. Please note: it is school policy that if you accompany the children on a trip you are not put in the same group as your child.
