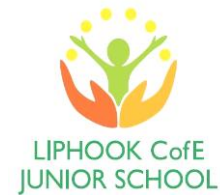

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our PSED (Personal, Social and Emotion Development) unit this term, we have a great opportunity to attend a Think Safe event held at Queen Elizabeth Country Park (QECP). Think safe involves children taking part in a range of different scenarios delivering key messages involving:

1. Hampshire Fire and Rescue Service - showing pupils what to do in the case of a fire
2. Royal National Life Boat Institute - Beach Safety.
3. Police - Stranger Danger
4. Southern Domestic Abuse Service - Healthy Relationships
5. Hampshire County Council - Trading Standards
6. EHDC Community Team - Internet Safety
7. Dog's Trust - dog awareness

The Year 6 children have been invited to attend the event on Monday 9th October 2017. We will need to leave school at 8:20 am to reach QECP in time for the beginning of the sessions. We would therefore like the children to be in school on this day by 8.15 am at the latest so we have enough time to take the register. The children will be leaving the sessions at 11:30 so will be back at school in time for lunch. Children will need to wear their school uniform.

- Please note that if your child requires an epipen he/she will be able to take the ones held in the classroom
- ** Children with asthma inhalers will take the ones that are held in class for them.

Children will be required to keep their bags/coats with them at all times - unfortunately there is no place available at QECP to store them. All children need to bring a drink, comfortable walking shoes and a coat are also recommended as there will be a short walk between scenarios

The cost of this trip is £5.75 per child which covers the event and the coaches. Voluntary contributions can be sent in by cash or cheque (payable to Liphook Junior School) or alternatively you can pay on line under the heading "QECP".

Please note that during the Fire Service scenario, artificial smoke is used. It will be possible to easily access the outdoors if necessary and will only be used for a very brief period. However, please ensure the adult in each group is aware of any reason why this may be a problem for a student in their group and advise the Fire Service staff at the beginning of that scenario if necessary.

Photographs will be taken to use for press releases and other East Hampshire District Council communications and websites, including Facebook and Twitter. **If YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR CHILD TO BE PHOTOGRAPHED PLEASE WRITE THIS CLEARLY ON THE REPLY SLIP BELOW.** We will advise them accordingly on the morning of arrival.
