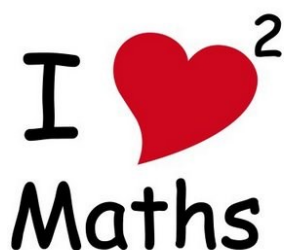
### **AUTISM? ADHD? HELP WITH PARENTING?**

We would just like to let everyone know that Barnardo's Hampshire Specialist Parenting Support Service will be running a Barnardo's Cygnet Autism course in **January**, at Alton College. This is for parents who have children with autism, please refer using the following link: <http://www.barnardos.org.uk/hspss.htm>. They also offer The Parent Factor in ADHD, and Family Links. Their criteria is to work with parents whose children either have a diagnosis of ASC or ADHD, or for parents who feel there are serious concerns about their children's behaviour which may warrant a CAMHS referral.
