We have arranged an exciting trip for your children on Monday 1st October to visit The Living Rainforest, Hampstead Norrey, Berkshire. During this trip the children will be having guided tours, Amazing Adaptations and Edible Forest to link to our topic of Rainforest Explorers. They offer a wide range of hands-on activities and each child will take part in a variety of activities during their visit. **Please note however that the children will be leaving at 8.15am prompt.** Details of the trip are as follows:

We have planned for the children to be back before the end of the school day but we also plan for any traffic delays. In the event of a delay the school will send you a text when the coaches are passing Farnham so that you will have plenty of time to walk/drive to school. If you want your child to walk home alone or be collected by someone else when the coach returns to school please indicate this clearly on the reply slip overleaf.

Should your child be entitled to free school meals a school lunch will be provided unless we hear from you to the contrary. Please note, a drink is not included in this so you will need to provide your child with a water bottle or squash (no fizzy drinks please).

As advised by the The Living Rainforest:

1. School polo-shirts and sweatshirts must be worn
2. Bring a packed lunch including a water bottle or drink

If your child uses an Epipen or an asthma inhaler these will be taken from the classroom.

There is no cost involved to you but you will need to bring a packed lunch/drink and appropriate clothing.
