We are learning about...

This half term the children will be studying the Ancient Greeks. During this topic the children will learn about the Olympic Games, traditional Greek cuisine, Greek myths and legends, clay pottery and art as well as taking part in a study of their own interest. Throughout the topic the children will be encouraged to read a range of fiction and non-fiction texts which develop their understanding, knowledge and interests of the topic. We will be studying the Olympics and using these sports skills to set up sport leading opportunities for the children.
